He served as a professor of medicine at the VCU School of Medicine from 1974 to 1988. Dr. Qureshi currently treats patients in Virginia Cancer Institute's Parham Doctors' Hospital location. His areas of special interest include benign and malignant hematology, colon cancer and hepatocellular carcinoma.

When he is not busy caring for his patients, Dr. Qureshi enjoys fly fishing and tending to his fruit tree orchard.
